

Are you Interested in a 50 Meter Indoor Pool in Williamsburg???

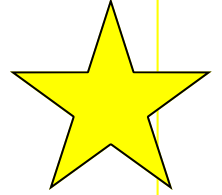

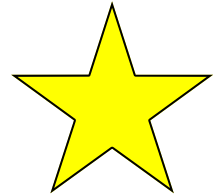
