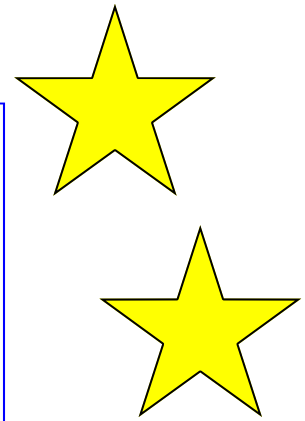

WAC IS TOP 2% IN THE NATION

Williamsburg Aquatic Club was ranked in the Top 5% of teams in the Country by United States Swimming for the 2006-2007 Short Course Season. The Club rankings were based on the top 2 times in every event in every age group. No swimmer can score more than 4 times in the virtual time championship. WAC finished 110 out of 2170 teams in the Country this year. During the 2005-2006 Short Course Season, WAC finished 46 out of 2168 teams in the country, earning the team a **Top 2% ranking**.
