NEW STATE RECORD

Joey Hewitt broke his own State Record at the recent Virginia State Swimming Championships in the 9 & 10 100 Breast. His time of 1:25.33 was almost a full second faster than the old mark. He is presently rated 1st in the county in the 50 & in the 100 Breaststroke. Joey won the 50 & 100 Breaststrokes at the recent State Meet, as did Peyton Young in the 11 & 12 age group.
