**New Assistant Coach / Rachel Horak**



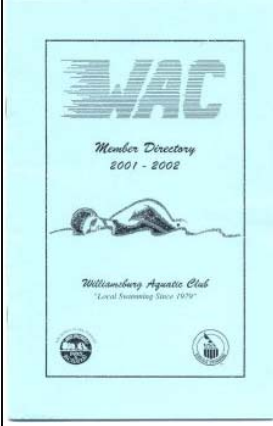
